Dear Parent / Carer,

This letter is to advise you of the beginning of our 'Bring Your Own Device' (BYOD) Program.

The BYOD program is beginning in 2015 on a voluntary basis.

Calwell High School is committed to supporting and developing students academically, socially and emotionally. It is of great importance that the school operates in partnership with families, and that we work together to achieve the best outcomes possible for your child. With this in mind, we ask that you look over the accompanying documents and consider whether BYOD is the right choice for your student/s.

All students are required to return an Acceptable Use of ICT and BYOD Agreement.

Students who are choosing to participate in the BYOD program must also have the BYOD Register completed by their parent/carer and the school.

Students who choose to participate in the BYOD program need to register their device with Alex Tandy on Thursday 29th January between 11am and 1pm at the IT Office.

From Week 1 of Term 1, 2015 there will be additional sessions on Tuesdays between 3:05 - 3:30pm and Thursdays in break times for students to register devices for use in the BYOD program*.

Devices will not be registered at any other times. Registration must be completed at Calwell High School by the designated BYOD Registration Officer before your student will be permitted to use their device on school grounds. Any unauthorised use of devices at Calwell High School may result in consequences in line with school policy, such as level agreements and restorative actions.
